SWITCHING TO THE SPEECH POSITION

NOTES

1 ITU-T Recommendation Q.157 was published in Fascicle VI.2 of the *Blue Book*. This file is an extract from the *Blue Book*. While the presentation and layout of the text might be slightly different from the *Blue Book* version, the contents of the file are identical to the *Blue Book* version and copyright conditions remain unchanged (see below).

2 In this Recommendation, the expression “Administration” is used for conciseness to indicate both a telecommunication administration and a recognized operating agency.

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3.7 SWITCHING TO THE SPEECH POSITION

At the outgoing and transit international exchanges, the circuit shall be switched to the speech position when the register (outgoing or transit) is released after sending the ST signal.

At the incoming international exchange, the circuit will be switched to the speech position when the register is released (see § 3.6.1 of Recommendation Q.156).
