NIST 800-171 revision 2 requirements 3.5.7 and 3.5.8 may be interpreted in a way misaligned with separate NIST recommendations for the use of infrequently-changed long passphrases rather than regularly-replaced short passwords, but do not clearly indicate that these recommendations are inapplicable. It should be clear whether application of these recommendations is appropriate or not.
